Before investing in your beautiful bespoke furniture piece, we suggest following our Will It Fit? guide to ensure your statement seating will be moved into your home with ease.

STEP 1: MEASURE YOUR ROOM


Before ordering your chosen furniture style, please be sure to map out where in your room of choice you want it placed. You can do this simply by laying masking tape or newspaper corresponding to the widest dimensions of the piece of furniture onto the floor. We provide full measurements for every piece of furniture we sell in the dimensions section of each product.

HOH TIP: Be sure to leave some room either side of your sofa as you don't want to wedge your furniture into its space. Ensure there is room to be able to walk around the sofa and to be able to put tables or lamps either side if desired.

STEP 2: MEASURE YOUR HOME

Next, taking into account the height (H), width (W) and depth (D) of the sofa, you will need to measure your home to ensure that we can get your chosen furniture style into your desired room.

Measure any doorways, hallways and stairwells that the sofa will need to pass through.




DOORWAY:

Opening up your door fully, measure the height and width of your door from the narrowest point of the frame. Make sure the height and width of the sofa is smaller than the height and width of your door. Remember to do this for both your front door and any other doors the sofa must pass through.

Ensure the path of entry is clear of obstructions and consider permanent fixtures such as boilers or lighting that may hamper delivery.



HALLWAY:

Measure the height, width and depth of any hallways at their narrowest points, checking they are larger than the height and width of your sofa. Take into account that different floors may have different ceiling heights or floor space.



STAIRWELL:

Measure the width of your stairs at their narrowest point and check if it's wider than the height of your sofa. Don't forget to consider light fixtures and handrails in your measurements.

If there are any landings, measure the height (X), width (Y) and depth (Z) of them, ensuring these are all larger than the height, width and depth of your sofa. Ensure (Y) is larger than the height (H) of your sofa.

Please take into consideration bannisters and light fixtures.
